

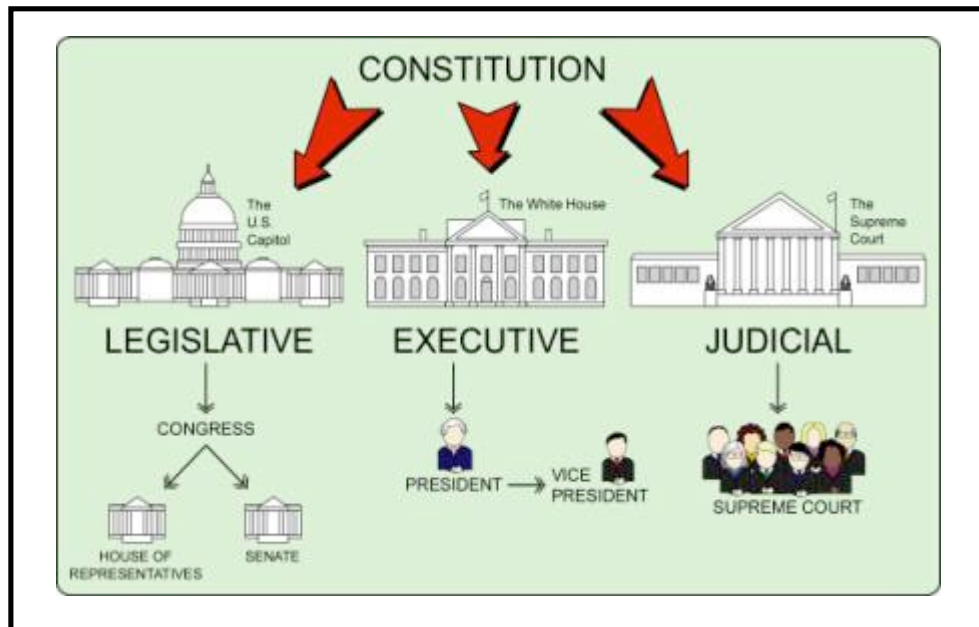
UNITED STATES HISTORY: QUARTER 1
