Special Meeting

At a Special Meeting of the Board of Education of the Fresno Unified School District, held on December 14, 2007, there were present Board Members Asadoorian, Davis, Johnson, Mills, Ryan, President Vang and *with Member Nunez absent*. Also present was Superintendent Hanson.

President Vang convened the meeting at 1:00 p.m. in the Board Room for the purpose to address the following agenda item:

1. 2006-2007 Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Fresno Unified School District and the Fresno Teachers Association

RATIFIED, as recommended, in accordance with Public Notice Section 3547 of the Government Code, (Statutes of 1981, Chapter 1213), all major provisions of collective bargaining agreements are to be presented at a public meeting of the public school employer before they enter into a written agreement.

Associate Superintendent Mecum presented for adoption a 3-year tentative contract agreement between the Fresno Unified School District and the Fresno Teachers Association. District staff thanked Larry Moore, FTA President and the FTA bargaining team members for partnering with the District for a combined effort to make Fresno Unified the Employer of Choice.

Superintendent Hanson commented that the contract notification from President Moore to District staff and stated that 73 percent of the membership responded and 94 percent of those responded voted 'yes'.

Member Davis moved for approval, seconded by Member Ryan, which carried a 6-0-1 vote *with Member Nunez absent*.

Superintendent Hanson questioned when Retroactive Checks will go out to the teachers?

CFO Quinto stated that the Retro-checks would be mailed on December 27th and should be received by December 28th.
